The Amsterdam Tournament takes place in Abcoude, a quaint little village a few kilometres south/south-east of Amsterdam. The organizer has a beautiful sports grounds with 4-5 pitches, and a spacious canteen with a bar and terrace. The terraces are laid out with festive stalls and a large grill during the event. The venue is only a few minutes' walk from the station, where you can catch a train for a 15-minute ride to the centre of Amsterdam.
