## Touristic information



### Rosmalen

Rosmalen (31,000 inhabitants) is the neighbouring community of 's-Hertogenbosch, capital of the province of North Brabant. It is a typical Brabantian town with a friendly, welcoming atmosphere in the centre. The Brabant Girls Cup is held at a royal sports complex with 9 pitches near the centre of Rosmalen, five kilometres from 's-Hertogenbosch.



### Den Bosch

There is an incredible amount to do and experience in the capital of North Brabant, 's-Hertogenbosch, also known as Den Bosch. For real culture vultures there are museums, boat trips and town tours. Shop-a-holics can really let loose in the various shopping streets, and there are also many cosy restaurants and bars. Don't forget to try the local speciality, the Bossche bol, a large cream profiterole in a chocolate shell.



### Party centre and activities: Hooghei

The Hooghei is located in a spectacular spot out in the countryside, with the surrounding woodlands providing the ideal place for some wonderful outdoor activities.
